 501 families searched for child care for 601 children
 92% of families used customized listing to search for child care

45,858 child care referrals made to families

Financial Assistance

Families saved approximately 29% of their child care costs

170 families received assistance for 178 children

Parent Education @ Work

62 parents of 74 children participated in learning sessions

75% of participants attended 6 out of 10 sessions

Training and Technical Assistance

207 training sessions totaling 541 training hours

Average 22-point increase in knowledge on pre- and post-test scores

100% of technical assistance recipients achieved 100% of quality improvement goals



Early Learning Resource Library and Van

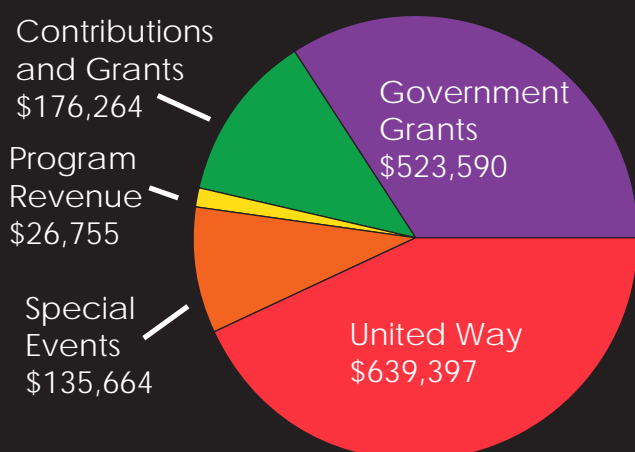
72 programs received visits from the van
 7,924 books and materials distributed to 480 patrons



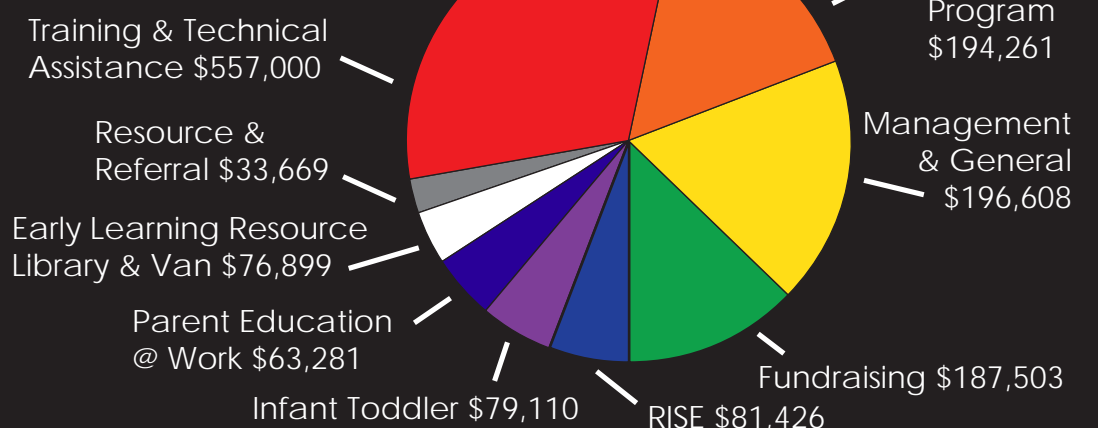
